# **PACE Clinical Services Program**

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The Positive Actions and Communication Experience (PACE) program introduces a model for exemplary leadership for students who suffer from Adverse Childhood Experiences (ACE) or ongoing mental health and behavioral life issues that continue to be a challenge to their personal growth and development. Students learn to recognize and observe disruptive, distractive, and disruptive behavioral, mental, and emotional patterns that can limit their human potential, health, and well-being.

The PACE program uses a blended learning approach where students receive individualized instruction combined with immersive social learning experiences, and clinical healthcare services to help them remove debilitating lifestyle patterns that can hinder the growth and personal well-being and development. Students work on personalized lessons, practice activities, develop action and leadership plans, and complete regular counseling sessions to help them stay on course to resolve and correct any adverse issues due to trauma and ACE symptoms.
